An important component of Hay Days Festival is our commitment to providing workshops that will share skills, culture and awareness of the arts and music in the South Slave region.

We invite you to facilitate workshops in your chosen art, craft, music or cultural background – for either Children 6 – 11 years old, Youth 12 – 18 years old, Adults 19 and over or Family.

The tentative workshop schedule is listed below. Due to COVID-19 all workshops are subject to change or cancellation on short notice. Facilitator and material fees will not be paid if cancelled.

Workshop facilitators will be required to provide all materials for their classes to help us ensure you have what is needed. Material fees will be collected and paid to you after your workshop is completed as will Facilitator fees. It is recommended that you plan workshops that will not require running tap water or electricity as workshops may have to move outdoors.

Workshop facilitators will be contacted in advance to submit a description and photograph of the workshop project that will be used on our website and other registration outreach.

We advise that there will be no cash advances or credits with local retailers provided to purchase materials or for Facilitator Fees.

Workshop facilitators will be required to provide a current (no older than 30 days from workshop date) **Canadian Criminal Records Check – Vulnerable Sector** if they will be hosting the children or youth workshops.

## **Facilitator Fees:**

\$500 for full workshop (6 to 9 hours) and may be split over two or three days if required \$250 for half day workshop (3 to 5 hours) and project should be completed

## **Number of Participants:**

Facilitator is responsible for setting the maximum number of participants, and should give consideration to social distancing due to COVID-19 protocols.
